Geoff Teall, head trainer and owner of Montoga, Inc has been involved in the horse industry for over 40 years. He has trained hunter champions and reserve champions at shows such as Lake Placid, South Hampton, Winter Equestrian Festival, Capital Challenge, Devon, Harrisburg, Washington, and the National Horse Show. He has also trained equitation champions and reserves at all major horse shows including the USEF Medal Finals, USEF Talent Search Finals, USEF Pony Medal Finals, THIS Children's Medal Finals, Ariat Adult Medal Finals and several different ASPCA Regional Finals. He has trained several jumper riders from the start of their jumper careers to their first Grand Prix wins.

Geoff holds his "R" Hunter and Hunter Equitation license. He has judged most major hunter shows including the Winter Equestrian Festival, Washington International Horse Show and the National Horse Show. In the equitation division he has judged several ASPCA Regional Finals, the Royal Winter Fair, WIHS Equitation Finals, the USEF Pony Medal Finals and the USEF Medal Finals.

Very involved in the governance of our sport Geoff currently serves on the Board of Directors of the USHJA and the USHJA Foundation. In addition he serves as Chairman of the WCHR Committee, Chairman of the Professionals Task Force and is also seated on the USHJA Hunter Working Group and the USEF Drugs and Medications Committee.

Geoff is also the author of "Geoff Teall on Hunters, Jumpers and Equitation" and contributes as a writer to many publications.





Dear Riders,

Thank you for your interest in our clinic series. Our August clinic will feature Geoff Teall. All riding sessions are limited to 5-6 riders per session; however, there is no limit to the number of auditors each day. The selection of all riding positions will be based on the riders' skill level and show record. Proper attire is required and ASTM/SEI helmets are mandatory.

A negative Coggins is required for ALL horses; please have the following available upon arrival:

- Proof of negative Coggins (must remain on Icon property at all times)
- Signed Icon Waiver (all junior riders must have waiver signed by BOTH their parent and trainer)
- Proof of annual vaccinations (vet certified)

RIDER APPLICATION

Geoff Teall Clinic Fee is \$575.00 per rider/horse and includes:

There will be a maximum of 6 horses per session.

Payment Policy:

- A 50% non-refundable deposit is required with all applications.

Reminder: proper riding attire (solid color polo) is required and ASTM/SEI helmets are mandatory. Icon is a private facility and riders are expected to clean stall daily as needed, rake the aisle ways, and general treat Icon facilities as if you were at home.

Equine Activity Liability Release,

Waiver of Rights to Sue and Assumption of all Risks

1. This Agreement is given under the Tennessee Code Annotated, title 44, chapter 20 (Acts 1992, Ch. 974, s 6.) as it may now provide or be hereafter amended (the "Code"). All terms defined by the Code shall have the same meaning herein, and the Code is hereby incorporated in this Agreement by reference. This Agreement shall be so construed as to provide to Chloe Desjarlais (which term shall also be deemed to include Le Renard, LLC) the fullest protection of a release, waiver of right to sue and assumption of all risks which is afforded to the Chloe Desjarlais by the Code. I understand and agree that Chloe Desjarlais is considered an "equine professionals" as used by the Code (see attached Code).
2. I understand that I am required to use ASTM/SEI protective headgear. I further acknowledge that I am required to wear protective footwear with heels. Chloe Desjarlais is not responsible if the proper headgear is not ASTM/SEI approved.
3. The undersigned hereby acknowledges that he/she has full and complete notice and understanding of the Code and of all the risks inherent to equine activities which may cause, contribute to or result in the death or personal injury of the participant or damage to the participant's property (the "Risks"), including, but no limited to: (i) the propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways or to tip and/or fall; (ii) the inability of anyone whomsoever to predict or predict or foresee an equine's reaction to excitement, weather conditions, sound, movements, objects, persons, animal, reptiles, birds or insects, and the effects of such reactions; (iii) the hazards of surface or subsurface conditions, including but not limited to objects or conditions on, under or protruding from the surface, both latent and patent; (iv) the hazards which rocks, cliffs, hills fences, trees, stumps, logs, bridges, ditches and other debris and obstacles, and any equine activities in connection therewith, may foreseeable or unforeseeably present; (v) the dangers and risks of tack or harness slipping or breaking for whatever reason; (vi) the dangers and risks of becoming entangled in tack, harness, or vehicles used in an equine activity, (vii) the risks of falling from or otherwise becoming unstable on an equine or a vehicle used in an equine activity for any reason whatsoever or for no identifiable reason and (viii) any negligent act or omission by Chloe Desjarlais which causes or results in the death or personal injury of the participant or damage to the participant's property.
4. The participant hereby RELEASES and WAIVES all rights which he/she may have or hereafter have against Chloe Desjarlais for death, personal injury or property damage which is in any way associated with the Risks; he/she does hereby WAIVE his/her right to sue or to bring any action against Chloe Desjarlais in connections therewith; he/she agrees to INDEMNIFY and DEFEND Chloe Desjarlais from and to HOLD Chloe Desjarlais HARMLESS against any such suit or action, and he hereby expressly ASSUMES ALL RISKS AND DANGERS of death, personal injury and property damage which are in any way associated with the Risks enumerated in paragraph 2, above. The waivers, releases and indemnities contained in this Paragraph 4 shall also apply to Icon Sporthorses, LLC, the Lessor of Le Renard, LLC.
5. The participant hereby authorizes and consents to any emergency medical care which may at the time appear reasonably appropriate under the circumstances as a result of injury or sickness caused by or incurred in the course of an equine activity.

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
